Volume 9. Two Germanies, 1961-1989 Statistics on East German Resettlers, Refugees, and Escapees (1961-1990)

The East German government played down the number of people killed at the Wall, whereas West German newspapers tended to exaggerate it. Varying accounts place the number of deaths at the Wall at less than 200 and at the inner-German border at around 1,100, with the exact count depending on who is included. By contrast, there are more accurate figures for the number of people who managed to resettle legally or escaped illegally – but both reflect the East Germans' constant desire to escape.
